

CHOCOLATE REVEL BARS

Ingredients:

1 Cup Butter

2 Cups Brown Sugar

2 Eggs

2 tsp Vanilla

2.5 Cups Flour

1 tsp Soda

- 1 tsp Salt
- 3 Cups Oatmeal

Filling:

12 oz Cholate Chips 15 oz Can of Sweetened Condensed Milk 2 TBPS butter ½ tsp salt

1 Cup Walnuts

2 tsp Vanilla

Directions: Cream butter and brown sugar together until light and fluffy. Mix eggs and Vanilla. Sift flour, soda and salt together. Stir in oatmeal to dry ingredients. Set aside.

Prepare filling by combining chocolate chips, milk, butter and salt in a double boiler. When chocolate mixture is smooth, add nuts and vanilla.

Spread 2/3 of oatmeal batter mixture into 9x13 pan, cover with chocolate mixture and dot with remaining oatmeal mixture.

Bake at 350* for 25-30 minutes.
